## **Comprehension Questions Examples**

Remember always get the children to evidence this from the text or illustrations. I know this because... follow up with why if not given

This is a few suggested questions and not an exhaustive list

	Knowledge of plot, events and character	Prediction of what might happen. (These questions need to be asked before reading the book, they are often based on the front cover, blurb or the first few pages)
Simple	Tell me something you can remember about the story.  Tell me something about a character from this book.  Tell me about one place in the story.  What happened at the beginning?  What happened at the end?  Did you like the book? Why?  What type of book is this?  Tell me some important things did?  Tell me what happens in the story?  Find a word in the book you liked, why?	What do you think this book might be about? Why?
Harder	Tell me three things you can remember about this story.  Name a character in this story and tell me something about them  Where does the story take place?  Tell me about the book cover? Why do you think this illustration was used?  Can you tell me why we should buy this book?  Tell me about some good/bad things the characters did.  Tell me 2 things that happen in the story in the order they happened?  Tell me something that went wrong in the story and how it got solved?  Can you tell me the whole story in your own words?  Tell me some good words in the story and what do they mean?	How do you think the story will start? What do you think will happen next? What kind of words do you think the author will use? What places will there be in the story? How might the story end? Looking at the cover and quickly looking at the pages what type of book/story is this?

Tell me 3 key things that happen in the story in the order they happen?  Order the problems in the story from major to minor?  How did the setting make the story more interesting?
