With Christmas approaching, many children may be receiving new devices. I would therefore like to draw your attention to the NSPCC's online safety advice for parents. Keeping our children safe online is more important than ever. Our recent safeguarding survey revealed that 60% of children surveyed in our school have been approached by a stranger online. While it was reassuring to see how many children knew what to do in these situations, it highlights just how essential it is for parents to be fully informed and to ensure that effective parental controls are in place at home.
